Proposed Answer	The National Digital Information Infrastructure and Preservation Program
	(NDIIPP).

Proposed Question	What does the LoC do?
Proposed Answer	Maintaining records that archive historical or cultural collections as well as
	collections subject to mandatory archival under U.S. copyright law.

Proposed Question	What did the NDIPP legislation call on the LoC to do?
Proposed Answer	Lead a public-private partnership in the development of a national approach to
	digital preservation. To collect, preserve, manage, and make available
	significant digital content, especially information that is created in digital form
	only, for current and future generations.

Proposed Question	What are the seven sustainability factors developed by the LoC?
Proposed Answer	Disclosure, adoption, transparency, self-documentation, external dependencies, impact of patents, and technical protection mechanisms.

Proposed Question	What are the four basic content categories initially adopted by the LoC?
Proposed Answer	Still images, sound, text, and moving images.
